- 2. All entries must be submitted to autumn.cantu@tananachiefs.org with their name, age, village, and grade the student is in.
- 3. All entries must be postmarked by May 30, 2020. This is the official close of the contest.

Entries postmarked after this date will not be considered.

- 4. Students may submit one entry per month in the contest. The contest is open to boys and girls in three groups; grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12. Group winners will be announced on Tanana Chiefs Conference Facebook page, TCC newsletter and receive a prize.
 - The first-place winner for each age group will receive a \$50.00 Amazon Gift Card
 - The second-place winner for each age group will each receive \$25.00 Amazon Gift Card
 - The third place winner for each age group will receive \$10.00 Amazon Gift Card

The artwork will be featured on the main Tanana Chiefs Conference website and in promotional materials.

- 5. All participants must be made by the student only. Parents/guardians, let your child show their creativity.
- 6. If your art piece is a snowman, clay creation or another form that cannot be sent through the mail or email, please take a picture of your creation and send it to the email provided.
- 7. All artwork must be original and pertain to the theme "Wellness and Prevention". The artwork must be the contestant's original creation. The entry design may not be a copy or duplicate of any previously published art, including photographs. No copying or tracing will be accepted.

The parent/guardian and student must sign an art and media release if they wish to enter the art contest.

- 8. The purpose of the art contest is to convey positive messages concerning the communities Wellness and Prevention.
- 9. Children with special needs may have assistance from their teachers, parents or guardians to help with their entry.
- 10. If you are chosen as a winner, you will be required to send a recent photograph of yourself.
- 12. Entries that do not comply with the contest requirements will be disqualified.
