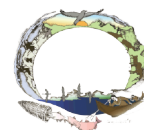


The Tanana Chiefs Conference (TCC) Fire Crew started in 2010. TCC established a Type 2 Initial Attack (IA) Crew consisting of 20 people based out of Tok, Alaska. Under contract, agencies use the crew to supplement their regular workforce in the event of wildfire emergencies.

Tanana Chiefs Type 2 IA Fire Crew is currently seeking highly motivated and committed candidates to fill available vacancies on the crew. This is a great opportunity to get fire experience and to advance your career in wildland fire.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- When called to an incident, expect to work 8-16 hours a day for up to 21 days committed while assigned to an incident.
- When not committed to an incident project, work will be available.
- Commitment to the crew for at the most 6 months.
- If you do not have the listed preferred qualifications S-130, S-190, and L-180 is offered on-line. A field day for the S-130 will be conducted at a later date. Classes are available on the NWCG Website
