



# **Infant Learning Program**

## **Services for Newborn to 36 Months**

- ❖ Home-based early intervention program.
- ❖ Supports and services to young children experiencing developmental delays/special needs and their families.
- ❖ Family centered services, meaning that each child is viewed in the context of their entire family and community.
- ❖ Family goals and needs are the center of services.
- ❖ Services to Interior Alaska including the road system, Interior Villages served by TCC, outside the Fairbanks North Star Borough (children/families do not have to be Tribal members).
- ❖ Individualized services to children and families through state funding through Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
- ❖ Transitions to pre-school, Head Start and Special Education.
