Veterans of Color Return to Work Co-Service Support Program

This program promotes the experiences of Veterans of color receiving services from State Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Tribal VR and the Veterans Affairs, (VA) VR&E program.

Program eligibility criteria:

- Must be a Veteran of color (i.e., African American/Black, Native American or Alaskan Native, Latino/Hispanic, or Asian American or Pacific Islander)
- Must have a Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) Counselor from the Department of Rehabilitation Services, or Tribal Vocational Rehabilitation or Veterans Affairs Vocational Readiness and Employment Counselor (VA VR&E)

Program will last approximately 6-8 months. Veterans will complete and participate in:

- 1. Pre-online survey
- 2. Telephonic Interview
- 3. Post-online survey

Pay: Veterans selected to participate will earn a \$2,000 stipend.
