Developing a health career path involves identifying interests (through career exploration activities) and aligning them with courses and other opportunities. TCC GO prepares the student to identify goals, choose postsecondary options, and transition to the workplace.

WHO SHOULD APPLY TO TCC GO?

Any Alaska Native high school student who is enrolled in a TCC region tribe or attending school within the TCC region, and who is:

- Interested in getting a head start on their college or technical program of study
- College ready and prepared to meet the challenges of University courses
- Willing to engage in career exploration activities

WHY?

Many students leave high school or begin college without a career plan or knowledge of job market needs.

Do you have any plans for your education or career after high school? If so, what are they? If not, what kinds of jobs or experiences (travel, learning new skills, etc.) do you think might interest you?
