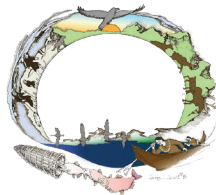

# Employment & Training

## Training Prerequisites



## Driver's Permit

- Pass the Written Knowledge Test.
- A Primary Document: Birth Certificate, Passport, OR a State ID.
- A Residential Address Document: Voter Registration Card, Utility Bill, Pay Stub, Tribal ID with address,
- School Records, OR Letter from Employer Verifying Address.
- Social Security Number: Must put either the SSN or documentation proving you do not have a SSN.
- Take it online @ <https://knowtodrive.com/alaska/>



## Driver's License

- Permit needs to be issued 6+ months before taking the DL Road Test for Youth.
- Pass the Vision Test, Road Test, and if over 21, pass the Alcohol & Drug Awareness Knowledge Test.
- All documentation listed for the Driver's Permit is required for the Driver's License as well.

## Class A CDL Permit

- Be 18+ Years Old
- Must have Driver's License for at least 1 year prior.
- Need to provide Proof of Citizenship Documentation.
- Must show Proof of Alaskan Residency.
- Social Security Number required for CDL.
- Cannot have a suspended CDL License in another state.
- Pass Written Knowledge Test.



## Class A CDL License

- Class A CDL Permit 14+ Days prior to the CDL Skills Test/Roads Test.
- Meet all requirements listed under Class A CDL Permit.
- Ending in 2025, listed below are some communities that do not need to take the Skills Test to get a CDL License: <https://doa.alaska.gov/dmv/reg/exempt.htm>



## Flagging

- Must be 18+ Years Old.
- Need Driver's License.
- Valid Flaggers Card.
  - » Can be obtained online or in person.

## 6 Pack Training

- Be 18+ Years Old.
- 360 Days of Boating Experience.
  - » Recency: 90 Days Must be in the Last Three Years.
- Pass Physical Exam and Drug Test.
- Current Adult CPR and First Aid Card.



## Hazwoper 40 Hour

- Be 18+ Years Old.
- One 40 Hour Course.
- Annual 8 Hour Refresher Course.



## Interested in Other Trainings?

Employment & Training has previously had trainings in Advanced Computer Skills, CPR Basic First Aid, Toyo Stove, Fiber Optics Installation, Heavy Equipment Maintenance, Asbestos, Solar Panel Installation, or Basic Construction.

If you are interested in other trainings, that are less than 3 weeks, you can apply for it to be covered under our Employment & Training Application.
