Higher Education Scholarship Opportunities for Interior Alaska Students

Introduction

This booklet serves as a comprehensive resource for rural Interior Alaska students continuing their education beyond high school. Whether you're a high school student preparing for college or vocational training, currently enrolled in a university program, or an adult learner returning to education, this guide will help you navigate financial opportunities and minimize student debt.

Finding and securing scholarships requires dedication and effort, but the financial benefits make it worthwhile. Begin by calculating your total educational expenses, including tuition, fees, meals, housing, and transportation. Alaskan students should note the significant advantages of in-state education: tuition-free options and exclusive access to State of Alaska scholarships.

Key Considerations

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov as early as possible. This application opens doors to federal aid and many state and private opportunities.
- Apply for scholarships well in advance of deadlines.
- Review eligibility requirements carefully, particularly regarding geographical restrictions or Tribal/organizational memberships.
- Submit all required financial aid documentation to your educational institution promptly.
- For single-year scholarships, plan to reapply annually.
- Most importantly, pursue scholarships first before applying for an educational grant or loan.
- If you are seeking GED support or a scholarship for vocational education, and these are not explicitly stated, please get in touch with the sponsoring organization.


