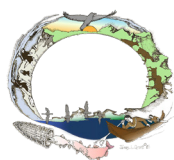

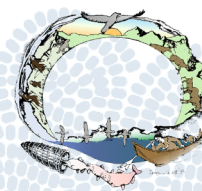

TCC GO is dedicated to helping Alaska Native high school students prepare for a career after graduation.

There is a wide range of potential job opportunities, and rural Alaska communities in particular are in need of trained professionals in fields such as health and education.

Students can learn about work in schools, hospitals, government agencies, in public health or health administration, tribal health consortiums or for non-profit groups. The choices are virtually limitless, especially with the expansion of internet access.

Developing a career path involves identifying interests (through career exploration activities) and aligning them with courses and other opportunities. TCC GO prepares the student to identify goals, choose postsecondary options, and transition to the workplace.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any student in 9th-12th grade **and** attending a village off the road system school within the TCC region **OR**, if attending school in Fairbanks, an Alaska Native high school student enrolled to a TCC region Tribe.

- Interested in getting a head start on their college or technical program of study
- College ready and prepared to meet the challenges of University courses
- Willing to engage in career exploration activities

Students must have their own email that is not provided by the school. If students need help setting up an email, we can assist them in creating a Gmail account.

WHY?

Many students leave high school or begin college without a career plan or knowledge of job market needs.

Do you have any plans for your education or career after high school? If so, what are they? If not, what kinds of jobs or experiences (travel, learning new skills, etc.) do you think might interest you?

As a TCC GO participant, you will learn what options might work best for you and how to pursue them – whether it's in a health related field or not. You will find support as you navigate the transition from high school to college or a vocational program.
