

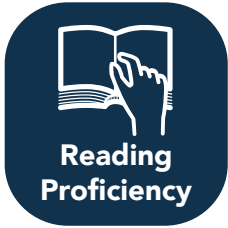

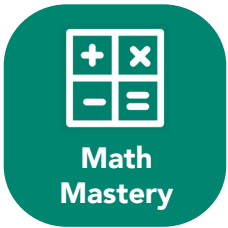


**Reading Proficiency**

**Math Mastery**

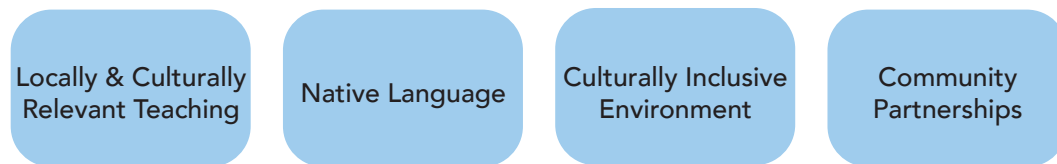


By May 2027, 75% of YKSD students will master foundational math skills by the end of sixth grade.

**Career & Tech Ed**

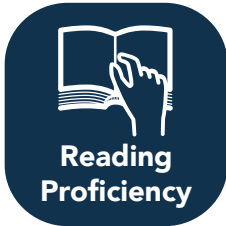


By May 2028, all students will graduate with the knowledge and skills necessary to pursue the career of their choice.

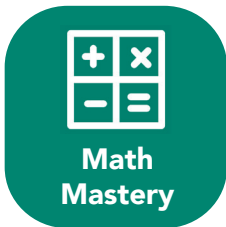

## DESCRIPTION



The emphasis of **Reading Proficiency** is to assure that every student is an active participant in high-quality, consistent, effective literacy learning and instruction. This focus area seeks to expose children to thorough well-rounded reading curricula that includes differentiated instruction, strategic interventions, and home supports to assure that every child is reading on grade level.



The emphasis of **Math Mastery** is to ensure that every child is an active participant in high-quality, consistent, effective math learning and instruction. This focus area seeks to engage children in thorough, well-rounded math curricula that includes differentiated instruction, strategic interventions, and home supports to ensure that every child is mastering math on grade level by the end of sixth grade.



**Cultural Infusion** focuses on building a co-learning environment to enhance relationships where everyone feels safe sharing and learning about culture. This focus area seeks to foster student cultural knowledge, language, self-identity, and academic achievement. The result of culturally infused schools are students and educators who are able to navigate and thrive in multicultural settings.



**Career and Technical Education** focuses on providing students with opportunities to explore career options and technical education. This focus area seeks to expose students to a variety of pathways, teach students valuable skills that they can apply in their daily life, certify students in certain trade skills, and prepare students for a variety of pathways after graduation.
